Brother Homero Luna has given his entire ministry to the Bible Methodist Church in Mexico. For more than 30 years he has devoted himself to the work of the Lord. Many of his family members are also deeply involved in our churches. Recently, Brother Homero's granddaughter, Dafne, was severely burned, when she pulled a pot of boiling water down on herself. She burned over 30 percent of her body, from her chin to her thighs. Most of her burns were 2nd and 3rd degree and required a lengthy hospital stay, along with special
