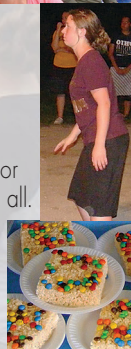

CAMP RULES:

1. All campers are expected to participate in the camp program as planned. This means attending all classes, services, activities, and cooperating with each counselor and the camp president to make the camp a benefit to all.
2. Campers are not permitted to leave the campgrounds unless given permission by the Camp Director.
3. No books or magazines are allowed.
4. Radios, CD players, MP3 players, and tape players are not permitted.
5. All campers are required to dress modestly at all times. Shorts and slacks will not be permitted for girls. Only "culottes" approved by the Youth Committee. For the approved pattern call Melba Sams, 937/855-6956. Also, all dresses and skirts must be of sufficient length to cover the knees whether sitting or standing, and of sufficient fullness as not to be form fitting. Boys will not be permitted to wear shorts, and all campers must wear apparel with sleeves. Dress codes are closely monitored.

WHEN DOES CAMP BEGIN AND END?

Registration opens Monday, at 1:00 p.m. Camp ends on Friday, at 3:30 p.m.

HOW OLD MUST I BE? 12-19 years old

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST? Camper Registration: \$85 if you register at the door. \$80 if you pre-register (you may pay at the door and still receive the \$5 discount). \$83 if you pre-register and pay online. Non camper Registration: \$20 per adult, and \$10 per non camper child.

WHAT DOES REGISTRATION INCLUDE? Room, food, board, and insurance for the entire week. Each camper receives one FREE trip to the snack bar each night and Friday "all you can eat" pizza!
