10. QUESTION: According to John 21:11, how many fish were caught by virtue of the miracle of the draught of fish?  
ANSWER: 153 (21:11)
11. QUESTION: What two miracles were performed on the Sea of Tiberias when Jesus told His disciples to cast their nets on the right side?  
ANSWER: A. The miracle of the draught of fish B. The miracle that nets did not break (21:11)
12. QUESTION: Why didn't the disciples ask Christ who He was when He appeared to them on the shore of the Sea of Tiberias following His resurrection?  
ANSWER: They knew it was the Lord (21:12)

17. QUESTION: How did Peter feel when Christ inquired concerning His love the third time?  
ANSWER: He was grieved (21:17)
18. QUESTION: What two things did Jesus say Peter was able to do when he was young?  
ANSWER: A. He girded himself B. He walked wherever he wanted to go (21:18)

19. QUESTION: What two things did Jesus say others would do for Peter when he was old?  
ANSWER: A. Others would gird him  
B. Others would carry him where he did not want to go (21:18)
20. QUESTION: Why did Jesus tell Peter that others would someday gird him and carry him where he did not want to go?  
ANSWER: To signify by what death he should glorify God (21:19)
21. QUESTION: What disciple asked, "Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee?"  
ANSWER: The one who was leaning on Jesus' breast (21:20)
22. QUESTION: After being told by what death he would glorify God, what question did Peter ask concerning the disciple who had lain on Jesus' breast at the last supper?  
ANSWER: "Lord, and what shall this man do?" (21:21)
23. QUESTION: **(Fill in the blanks)** Jesus said to Peter, "If I will that he \_\_\_\_\_ till I \_\_\_\_\_, what is that to thee? \_\_\_\_\_ thou me."  
ANSWER: A. Tarry B. Come C. Follow (21:22)
