ANSWER: "Shall I go up again to battle against the children of Benjamin my brother?" (20:23)

ANSWER: From Jabesh-gilead (21:14)
10. QUESTION: Who asked the question, "How shall we do for wives for them that remain, seeing the women are destroyed out of Benjamin?"  
ANSWER: The elders of the congregation (21:16)
11. QUESTION: What was held every year in Shiloh?  
ANSWER: A feast of the Lord (21:19)
12. QUESTION: Whose daughters were the men of Benjamin permitted to catch for their wives?  
ANSWER: The daughters of Shiloh (21:21)
13. QUESTION: What three things did the men of Benjamin do after they caught wives for themselves of the daughters of Shiloh?  
ANSWER: A. They returned unto their inheritance B. They repaired their cities  
C. They dwelt in their cities (21:23)
14. QUESTION: Where did the people of Israel go after they had solved their problem with the children of Benjamin?
