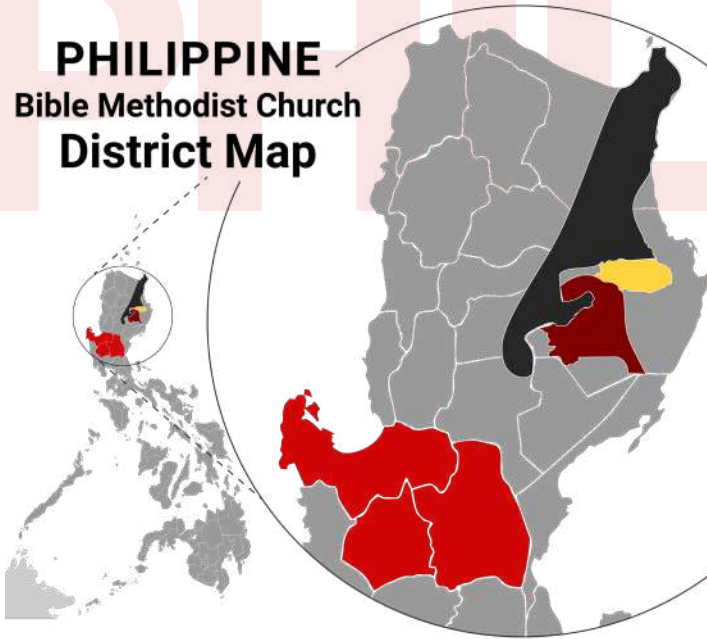

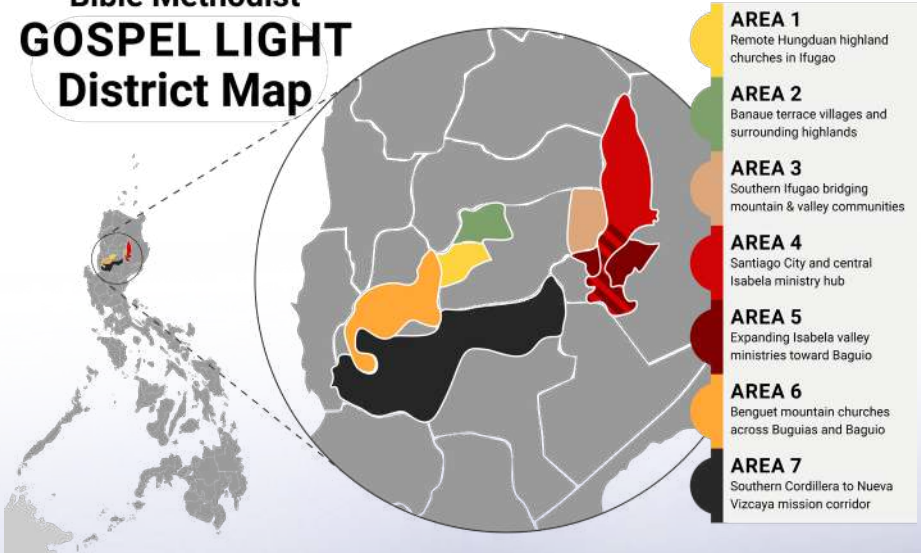

BMGL WORKER TRAINING PROGRAM

How to Pray for the Philippines:

1. Church Planting in Unreached Areas

Pray for the establishment of healthy churches among indigenous peoples and in isolated communities, as well as wisdom for workers battling spiritual apathy or opposition. According to some estimates, out of 42,000 local communities (barangays) in the Philippines, approximately 23,000 communities still do not have an evangelical church. This represents 30 million people.

2. Development of Local Leaders & Missionaries

Pray for the training of more young Filipino pastors, church-planters, and missionaries so that local churches will be grounded in the Word of God, and the gospel will spread to more communities in the Philippines and beyond.

3. Doctrinal Purity and Holy Living

Pray that our brothers and sisters in the Philippines will hold fast to sound doctrine, rooted in scripture, and that they will pursue holy lives that are being conformed to Christ and not to the spirit of this present world.

How to Pray for Mexico:

1. Protection from Violence and Cartels

Pray for the safety of missionaries and local pastors operating in areas controlled by cartel violence, particularly in regions experiencing instability and danger.

2. Safety for Persecuted Believers

Intercede for evangelical Christians facing intense persecution, especially indigenous believers driven from their homes or restricted by local, traditionalist authorities.

3. Spiritual Renewal and Gospel Clarity

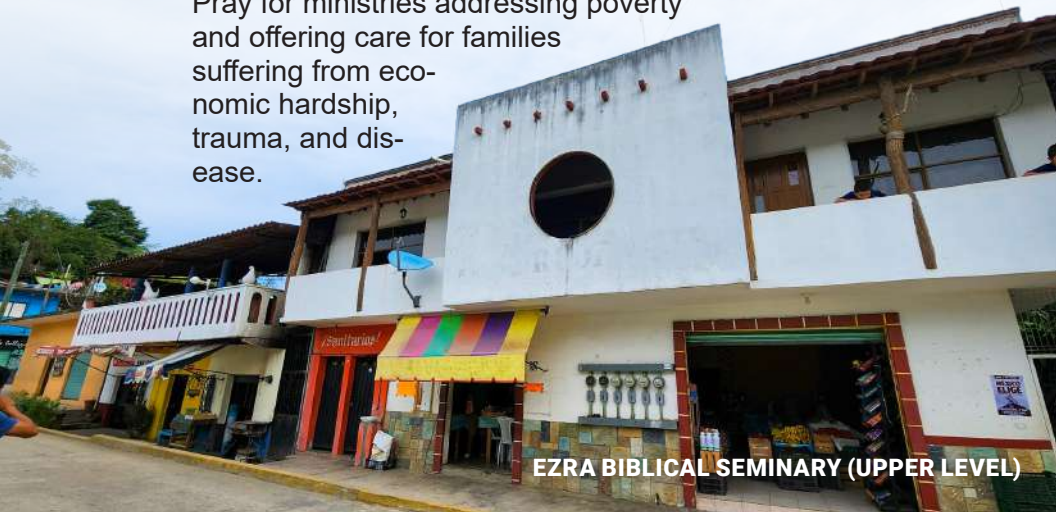
Pray against deep-seated syncretism—the mixing of traditional religious rituals with Christianity—and for a move of the Holy Spirit leading to authentic salvation experiences.

4. Equipping Local Leaders and Church Planting

Ask for the multiplication of healthy churches and the strengthening of theological training centers to raise up humble, sound, and effective local leaders.

5. Meeting Physical and Social Needs

Pray for ministries addressing poverty and offering care for families suffering from economic hardship, trauma, and disease.

How to Pray for the Continent of Africa:



1. **Safety and Protection for Missionaries:**

Pray for protection from violence, thieves, and bandits in areas of political instability, as well as safety during travel in challenging environments.

2. **Leadership Training and Theological Education:**

Pray for the training of pastors and church leaders, equipping them to teach sound doctrine, address syncretism, and establish healthy, biblical churches.

3. **Unreached People Groups (UPGs):**

Pray for the gospel to reach over 1,000+ unreached groups, especially across the Sahel and North Africa, overcoming religious and cultural barriers.

4. **Church Growth and Revival:**

Pray for the African church to experience continued spiritual renewal, unity, and a stronger commitment to local missions, effectively dealing with the influence of false doctrine or traditional religions.

5. **Provision and Humanitarian Support:**

Pray for the provision of resources to meet practical needs like food, clean water, healthcare, and educational initiatives that facilitate community development alongside evangelism.

Pray for the unity of the Spirit within local churches that are isolated and culturally diverse, overcoming divisions, while fostering a strong commitment to scriptural holiness.

4. National Leader Development and Training:

Pray for the training and encouragement of indigenous pastors and leaders.

5. Provision for Physical and Logistical Needs:

Pray for the physical health and safety of pastors, Christian workers, Bible school students, and missionaries, along with the necessary funding and resources—such as vehicles, food, and housing—to support their work in challenging environments.
